

Fire Drill Procedures

Fire drills are held at Cabri School at least six times a year, in a variety of weather conditions and during different days & times to create as many scenarios as possible so students and staff are prepared in the event of an actual emergency. All fire drills are timed to ensure we are completing the drill in a timely manner and all drills are reported to Chinook School Division.

Students are taught where the nearest exit is in relation to the classroom they are in. When the fire alarm sounds, students exit the building quickly, but without running. Staff have assigned areas in the school to check and doors are closed as staff check each area. All students and staff meet in the drop off area in front of the elementary doors and students line up in their classes. Students are quickly counted to ensure everyone is there and staff reports student attendance and checked areas to the office manager. Once all students and staff are accounted for and all areas have been reported checked and cleared, the fire drill timing stops.
