

INTERVENTION

Intervention is **extra support for all students in grades 6-12.** It is **20 minutes of daily instructional time** when students have the opportunity to get **extra one-on-one or small group help in any subject area or have extra time to work on school assignments.** It is **mandatory for all students in grades 6-12.** This is not a spare.

Students will be assigned to specific subject areas if evidence shows they need extra support or extra work time in a class. If students are not assigned to a specific subject area, they will choose which class they will work in for each day's intervention time.

Parental contact is not made every time a student is assigned to intervention. A **teacher will call home if the student is assigned to intervention to complete an assignment by a second due date or if the student does not show up** for assigned intervention time. If a student in grade 11 or 12, who has a spare in their schedule, continues to miss assigned intervention, **they may lose their spares** in order to complete the necessary work from the missed intervention time.
