

Kindergarten Supply List

1 set of washable markers - Please be sure it includes black, brown, orange, red, yellow, blue, green, and purple. This set of 8 is really all they need, but if you wish to purchase other colors, that's OK. Crayola Pip Squeaks or Dollarama has some as well.

Scissors

Paint shirt - An old shirt of mom's or dad's with the sleeves cut to fit will work just fine.

Glue - 6 LARGE glue sticks

4 pencils

1 pair of gym shoes - these stay at the school and are only worn inside. If your child can't tie their own shoes, please send Velcro.

1 backpack - Be sure they can manage opening and closing it themselves.

1 pencil box - large enough to hold scissors, 1 glue stick, markers, and pencil

1 large box of Kleenex

1 pkg of plastic forks or spoons - We keep these in the cupboard for the times they forget to pack one in their lunch. I have lots of plastic knives, so we don't need more of those.

1 water bottle- preferably one that doesn't require them to twist off and one that doesn't spill easily☺

Snack - Please send them their own snack in their lunch kits each day. This removes worries about food allergies and they get a snack they are sure to like and that you want them to have.

I will purchase - There will be a charge for notebooks, day planner, take home folder and duo tangs in the fall. The notebook is for drawing pictures and writing for a journal. I'll let you know the cost in September.

1 small travel bottle of hand sanitizer (to refill)

Please don't send wax or pencil crayons. I have lots at school for when they need them.

Print your child's name or initials on EVERYTHING they bring to school, including each marker. It is so much easier to return found items to their owner if names are on them. (DON'T worry about sharpening everything I have and electric sharpener☺)

Please try to send everything the first couple days of school. It's easier to keep it here at school in a bag for each child so they have access to the extra materials as they need them.
