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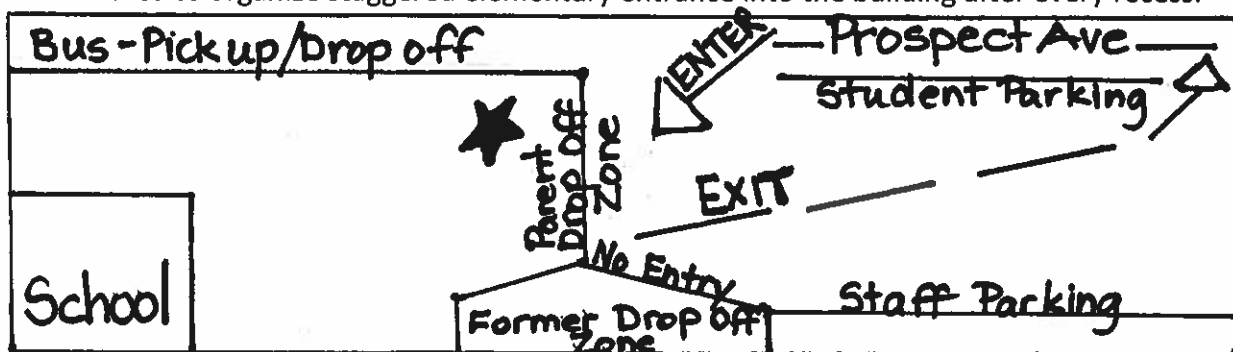
Dear Cabri School Families,

We are very much looking forward to seeing your child(ren) back at school on September 8th. We've had some questions about **picture day**. This year it is **September 17th**. We know many are wondering about specific things we will be doing at Cabri School to keep students and staff safe when students return. **We have spent many hours creating plans to follow the Saskatchewan Health Authority & Chinook School Division's guidelines** and yesterday was the first day all staff was back in the building to review and modify plans to make them work for our students. Please know that these plans may evolve based on our experience in using them in the first days and weeks of school and if we receive new recommendations from Sask Health if the situation with the virus changes. If you have any questions at all, please contact the school and we will get back to you asap (please know we now have voice mail at the school and you can leave a message for us anytime).

Our plan is very extensive and here are the main points (some directly from Sask Health):

- **No students or staff can come to school if they have any symptoms.** Anyone who develops symptoms while at school will need to go home immediately (we have a team of staff who will support children with symptoms in a designated isolation room while we await parent pick up). **If your child is absent from school, you will need to call the office and let Lori know the reason your child is absent** (as per direction from Sask Health).
- **Anyone in grades 4-12 who cannot maintain a minimum of 1 metre distance from others will be required to wear a mask**, both in classrooms and common areas. Staff will remind students when they need to put on their mask. **Please ensure your child comes to school every day with a clean mask.**
- **We've been directed to only allow essential visitors into the school.** If you have to pick up your child or have something that you need to drop off for them, please call the office at 306-587-2229. Lori will arrange for your child to meet you outside in the parking lot or will let your child know that they need to come and pick up a drop off. There is a drop off/pick up box at the front door for items needing to be exchanged. Anyone who is deemed to be an essential visitor to the school will have to answer screening questions from their phone before they will be permitted to enter and will have to fill out a detailed sign in sheet.
- All students will stay within their grade cohorts (K, 1, 2/3, 4/5, 6/7, 8/9 & 10/11/12) while at school and will not be mixing with students in other cohorts.
- All students will have to **sanitize their hands when they enter and leave the building, enter and leave their classrooms and before and after eating lunch.** There are sanitizing stations and sinks throughout the school for student use. **All desk surfaces and commonly touched areas will be regularly sanitized throughout the day.**
- Students will be assigned lockers to hold their belongings but **locker use will be restricted to designated times directed by teachers to maintain physical distancing.**
- **Signage has been posted throughout the school** to remind everyone about safety procedures.
- **If your child(ren) take the bus**, your bus driver will be in touch with specific bus information.

- **Lunch time: If your child(ren) live in town**, we strongly encourage them to go home for lunch if at all possible. **If your child(ren) stays at school for lunch** they will be eating in their homeroom with their cohort. Elementary students will go outside for recess after they've eaten. Grade 6-12 students will not be permitted to have an open gym like is tradition but if they need physical activity or fresh air, they will be permitted to walk the track area as long as they stay physically distanced and only with people in their cohort.
- **During elementary recess, cohorts will be assigned zones where they will play and these zones will rotate throughout the day.** Every child will sanitize their hands before and after recess and each cohort will have their own soccer and basketballs so that equipment is not shared between cohorts.
- **Microwaves, water fountains and the pop machine will not be available for student use** to limit potential spreading of germs. Students are asked to bring a full water bottle from home every day and we will have a water cooler available for students to use with teacher supervision if they require a refill.
- At this point we are awaiting final direction from Chinook about **extra-curricular activities** and we know their hope is that we can offer safe, modified versions of these important events.
- For **grades 6-12 students, we will not be able to have intervention time** as it involves mixing of cohorts. This has resulted in those minutes being added back into class time but due to missing the 5 minutes transition times before and after intervention, the bell schedule has been slightly altered. **Please see the attached updated bell schedule.** Any grade 6-12 students requiring extra support from a teacher can arrange for that help at noon, after the end of day dismissal (there will be 15 minutes available before buses leave) or at another time that works for both of them.
- Due to the essential visitor policy & not being able to mix cohort groups, **we unfortunately will not be able to have our annual back pack drop off night before school begins.** School supplies will be brought by students on their first day of school. They will have to enter the building on their own but staff will be around to assist in anyway needed. Please ensure your child(ren) has all their supplies on the first day and everything is labelled with their name as we cannot have any shared supplies this year.
- **If you are dropping off your child(ren) at school, please use the following sketch to confirm where the drop off area is.** The former drop off zone is no longer available as it has become a muster area to organize staggered elementary entrance into the building after every recess.



Kindergarten parents, you will be getting a separate email this afternoon with the revised schedule and additional information. If you have any questions at all, please contact the school and we will get back to you asap. We look forward to seeing all our students on the 8th!

**Due to safety concerns, elementary students leave the school in two groups at 3:30 dismissal. Bus students leave first followed by students walking (who will leave after the buses are gone). Students who are being picked up by an adult may leave the school with that adult once the 3:30 bell has gone and the teacher is aware that the student is leaving. Student safety is our first priority.*
