### **Chinook's Weather Policy**

As we are now into the winter season, we would like to remind all parents about the Chinook School Division's Weather Policy. Schools are never closed due to weather, but parents obviously make the decision about weather they will send their children to school during inclement weather. Busses will not run if the actual temperature at their location is  $-40^{\circ}\text{C}$  or colder, or if the temperature with the wind chill is  $-45^{\circ}\text{C}$  or colder. Bus drivers may choose to not drive their buses when they feel it is not safe to do so. If buses are cancelled due to weather, bus drivers will notify their parents and Mrs. Thomas. Mrs. Thomas will notify the radio station (FM 94.1 and 97.1). If you have any questions please call Mrs. Thomas at the school.
