

### SYA Entry Requirements:

The following criteria must be met:

- Registered as a Saskatchewan secondary student,
- Must be at least 15 years of age and in Grade 10 or above,
- Must meet one of the following criteria:
  - experience with part-time or seasonal employment
  - registered in a Practical and Applied Arts class
  - registered in a trade-related locally developed course
  - registered in Career and Work Exploration
  - registered in a PAA survey course with at least one-third trade-related content

### SYA Contract:

After verification of the entry requirements, students receive and sign a SYA contract registered by the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission (SATCC).

The contract identifies the student as a Youth Apprentice. It sets out the requirements of the Youth Apprentice to participate in the program.
