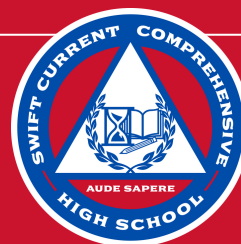

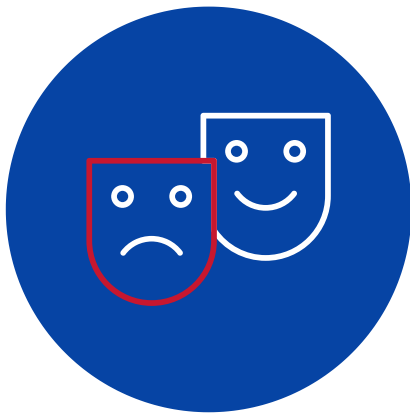

Waitlist yearbooks will be given out based on the order of the waitlist. However, if those on the list do not pick up promptly, the next person on the waitlist will receive priority and so on.

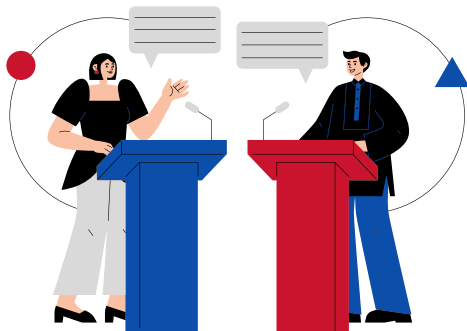
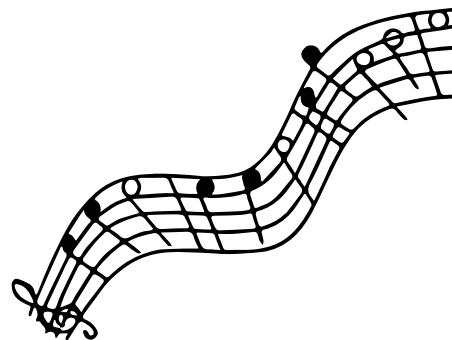
2023-2024 Course Selection Process

During February and March, students in 9, 10 and 11 will be participating in course selection presentations during their Semester 2 ELA classes. During these presentations, students will receive information about requirements for their upcoming grade and receive a course selection form. Students are asked to review course options with parents / guardians to make sure they are choosing the courses that will be best for them. Completed forms are to be returned to their ELA teachers by the deadline provided to students.

Four SCCHS teams will compete in this tournament.

The students will debate in all levels from Grade 5 to 12 on the following prepared motions:

The eligibility criteria to be considered for Horatio Alger National Entrepreneurial and Canadian Scholarship are as follows:

- Be enrolled full time as a high school grade 11 student.
- Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in Canada.
- Demonstrate critical financial need (\$65,000) or lower adjusted gross family income is required)
- Be involved in co-curricular and community service activities
- Display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity
- Hold a minimum of 70%
- Be a Canadian Citizen
