Morning of Wednesday, September 6, 2023

- \Rightarrow Students will find their Homeroom listed on the main school doors and in the main lobby.
- \Rightarrow Students will report directly to their Homeroom upon entering the building.
- \Rightarrow Students will have their yearbook/school picture taken during registration time.
- \Rightarrow Students will pay the 2023/2024School Fee of \$20 directly to their homeroom teacher. Cash or Cheques (made out to SCCHS) only.
