### WHAT IS THE SASK ICE UNIT?

The Saskatchewan Internet Child Exploitation Unit (Sask ICE) is an integrated Unit that falls under the Criminal Investigations Division of the Regina Police Service. Due to the increasing crimes of exploiting children through the use of the Internet the Sask ICE Unit became operational in the spring of 2009. The Units mandate is to reduce Internet facilitated child sexual exploitation by identifying victimized children and investigating and assisting in the prosecution of sexual offenders.
