RE: MySchoolSask – New Student Information System



In the fall of 2019, Chinook School Division plans to move to a new unified Student Information System (SIS) for Saskatchewan that will be used at the provincial, school division and school levels. Branded as “MySchoolSask”, the new SIS is a centralized platform for safely and securely hosting and managing student data.

MySchoolSask is a provincial solution that will provide a great opportunity for parents and guardians to engage in student learning. Through the parent portal, you can expect to have similar access to your child’s gradebook, along with some enhancements and improvements. Student tracking, reporting and learning information will move with each student, which will lead to more seamless transitions between schools and divisions.

We would like to acknowledge and thank our Chinook MySchoolSask Trainer Team, which includes teacher and support staff representatives from various schools, for being willing to lead the implementation and training for this new system. The team has been busy learning about MySchoolSask and preparing for the implementation and training in the schools with all staff user groups.

We expect that this will be a seamless transition and once the program is implemented, parents will still have an opportunity to access grades and view attendance online.

We will be communicating our progress and any changes to families as we move ahead with implementation, which is planned for school start-up in the fall of 2019. Please watch for more information to come!
