**RE:** MySchoolSask – New Student Information System

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As you are likely aware, this fall, Chinook School Division is moving to a new unified Student Information System. Branded as “MySchoolSask”, the new SIS is a centralized platform for safely and securely hosting and managing student data.

MySchoolSask is a provincial solution that will provide a great opportunity for parents and guardians to engage in student learning. Although the user interface will look different on the new parent/family portal, you will have very similar in-time online access to your child’s grades and attendance as you have had in the past, along with many enhancements and improvements.

Student tracking, reporting and learning information will move with each student, which will lead to more seamless transitions between schools and divisions. The Chinook MySchoolSask Trainer Team, which includes teacher and support staff representatives from various schools, has been busy with MySchoolSask planning, implementation in the schools and staff training.

User log-in information and instructions for the new family portal on MySchoolSask will be shared with parents and students early in the school year, once the system is fully implemented, and we will provide updates as needed.

There have been a number of dedicated Chinook staff working tirelessly behind the scenes to make our division’s transition to this new system as seamless as possible. We believe that MySchoolSask will be a far superior and more reliable student data system than what we are presently using. We are hopeful that you too, in the end, will have a better user experience.
