Re: Gym Shoes for Phys. Ed. Classes

Many of the new "gym shoes" that are available in stores are not safe. Please check for the following when purchasing gym runners for your child:

- 1) Adequate grip on soles that are non-marking. If the sole feels smooth/ slippery, it will be dangerous once it is on the gym's floor surface.
- 2) Velcro or shoelaces- Only choose shoelaces if your child can tie and double-knot the laces independently; slip-on shoes are not safe- it is easy to roll an ankle and they fly off during games such as soccer, injuring other children.

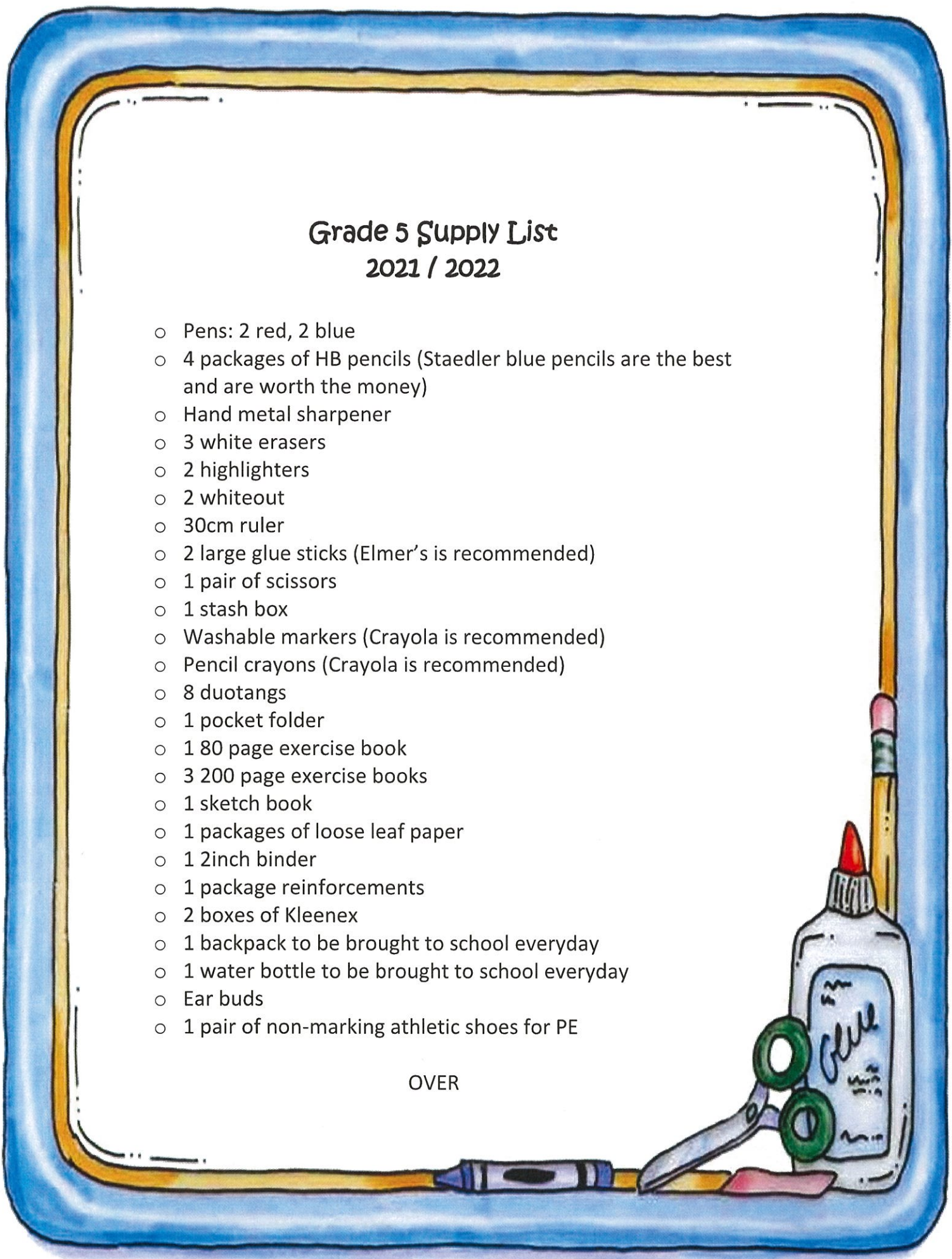

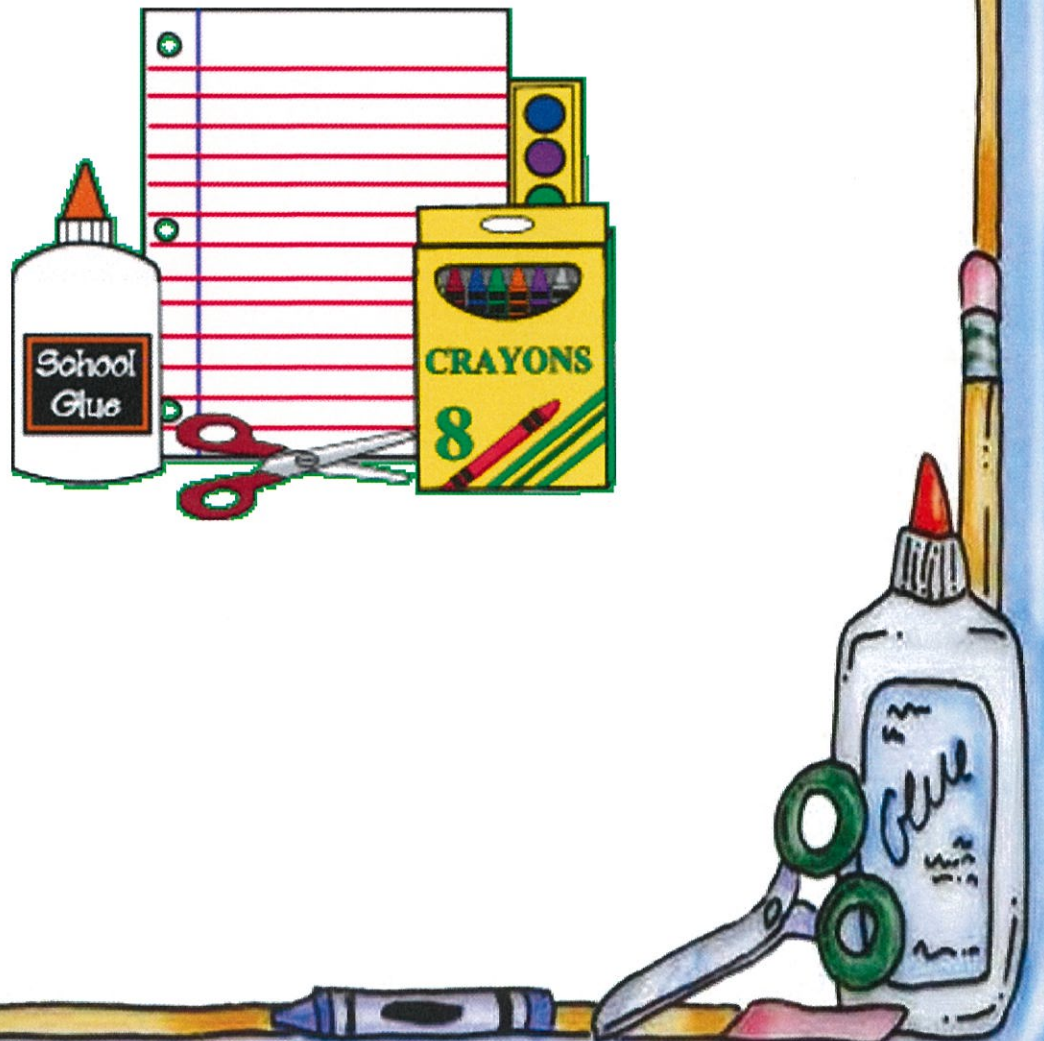

1 pair of headphones or earbuds (it doesn't matter what kind they are, but they will be your own personal set to keep here)

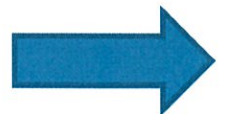
