# ESSENTIAL MEDICATIONS & HEALTH-RELATED PROCEDURES

If essential medications and/or health-related procedures are required at school, parents are required to request the service and/or procedures in writing. Please send this written request and information with your child to be delivered directly to the school office.

#### DRESS CODE

Because of the warm weather to come, parents and students may need to be reminded of our school dress code indicating appropriate clothes for school.

School dress should reflect good taste and judgement. The type of dress worn by the student has an influence on the student's attitude and work and on the character of the school. With this in mind, the following guidelines should apply:

Clothing should not be offensive to others (i.e., containing racist, sexist, or profane language or images, or references to drugs or alcohol).
Clothing should not be revealing or allow for excessive skin exposure.

- Head gear (hats, bandanas, etc.) and sunglasses must be removed upon entering the school building and stored in lockers.

- Students must remove wet or muddy footwear. Students should have other footwear available in this event.

- Physical Education Wear: Students should wear a change of clothes to physical education class that allows comfort, freedom of movement required by all class activities, along with running shoes that have not been worn outside. All physical education dress should respectfully meet school dress code.

Students may be asked to go home or to call their parents to bring appropriate clothing. School t-shirts are available for students to wear for the day so that they do not have to go home. Please contact the school if there are any questions.

### **TRACK & FIELD TEAM**

We have had an interesting start to this 2024 Track & Field season! We were all very excited to start on Apr. 22 with approx. 28 athletes participating and 3 coaches - Ms. Foley, Mr. Zielke, and Ms. Chabot. Although not required, we do encourage athletes to have new or used cleats lined up for the season. Cleats need to have size 7 (6mm) spikes to be legal on rubber tracks where qualifying competitions & invitational meets are held. SHS Track uniforms will be available for all athletes when competing, but it is necessary that they have their own black shorts and weather-appropriate layers. We are excited to announce that our SHS T&F online store will be shared with athletes and families shortly for anyone wanting to order team clothing, cleats, and sack packs. We also have a Track & Field Team Google Classroom now for communicating all things team and meet entries throughout the season.

The athlete expectations for the 2024 season are:

- Provide their own shorts (black) and track cleats (excluding throwers). Cleats need to have size 7 (6mm) spikes. It is recommended to replace spikes annually.
- \$50.00 Track and Field team fee paid.
- Water bottles and layers brought to ALL practices and competitions.
- Attend a minimum of TWO practices per week, including Monday, and either Tuesday or Thursday. (Thursday's practices will have a focus on recovery)
- Attend at least ONE of the Invitational Meets and register by all meet deadlines.
- Be available to compete in the following major competitions: SHS Qualifying Days, Sectionals, Districts, Provincials.
- Respect and care for the team

uniform provided; promptly returning uniform when the season finishes.

- Compete in a minimum of THREE events (max of four) plus relay at competitions.
- Report injuries to the head coach and their event coach on the day of injury.
- Understand there is a policy of ZERO tolerance for the following substance use before, during, and after team activities while representing the team: alcohol, tobacco, tobacco replacement products, energy drinks, cannabis products, or any other illicit drug.
- Understand that they are student athletes, and they must make academics their priority. No skipping class, demonstration of appropriate behaviours inside and outside the classroom, maintaining and passing courses, paying all school fees.
- Conduct themselves in a positive and respectable manner. You are representing yourself, your school, and your community.
